Natural Gas Generators

- Many models operate during power outages.
- Twice the capacity in half the recovery time of electric models.
- Lower maintenance and longer life cycle than electric models.

Natural Gas Ranges

- Stovetops operate during power outages.
- Burners can be lit with a match or portable igniter.
- Precise temperature control.

Natural Gas Grills

- Operate during power outages.
- Provide the comfort of being able to prepare hot meals.
- Many models of grills have additional side burners for pots and pans so you can easily boil water.

- Provide comfort and security during the night without the worry of using up all of your batteries or the fire danger of candles.
